



# Author meets her Tweed fans

INTERNATIONAL best selling author Paullina Simons stopped into Kingscliff for a chat and meal on Wednesday.

The author, most famous for *The Bronze Horseman* trilogy, was in town to promote her latest book *Children of Liberty*.

She's no stranger to Australian shores, but in her past four visits she had never seen the Tweed coastline.

"It's very beautiful here,"

she said.

"Like the United States it has beautiful beaches and seaside towns."

About 60 ladies attended the Kingscliff's Boardwalk Books event at Babalou restaurant.

"They were all huge fans," Boardwalk Books employee Nicki Tait said.

She touched down a week ago and has two weeks left of her Australian and New Zealand launch tour.

A second part to *Children of Liberty* is due out next October and another new title in 2015.
